- We have a full-time counselor to support our students' emotional needs

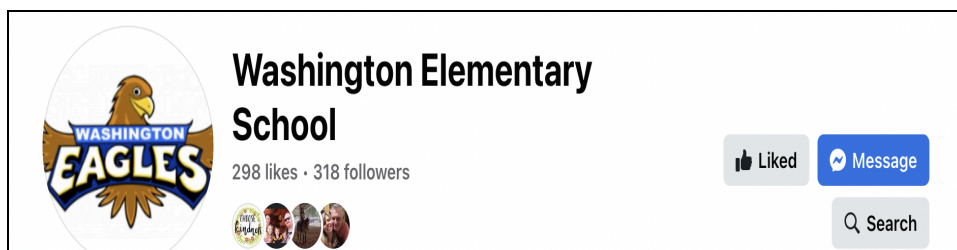
## School Culture

- Our Hot Dog Dinner Night is in May and is a great time for our school community to come together!

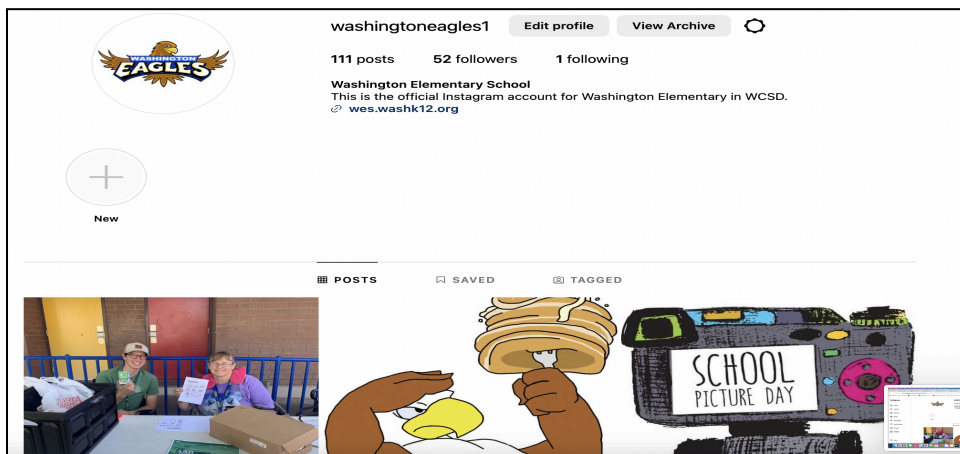
## Family Information
